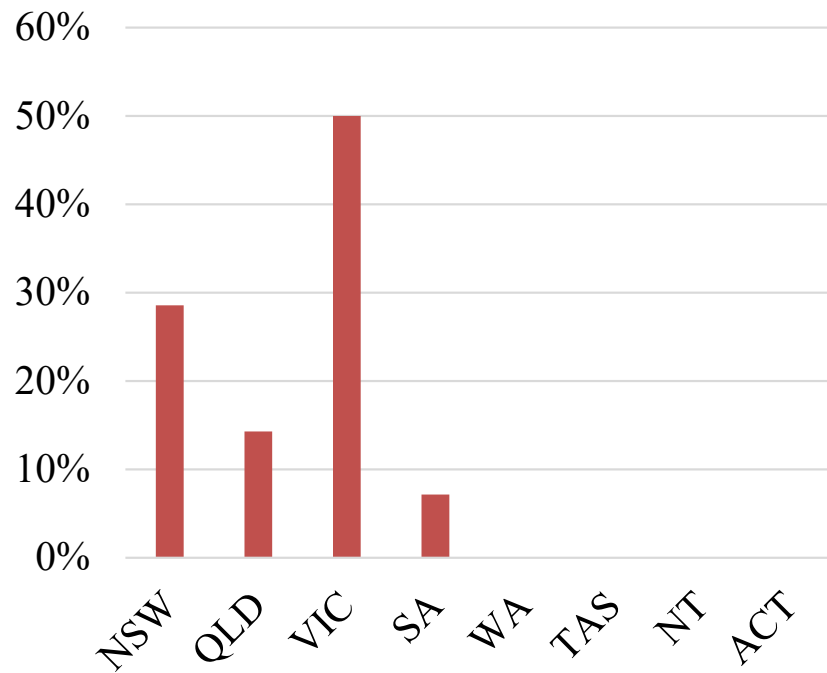

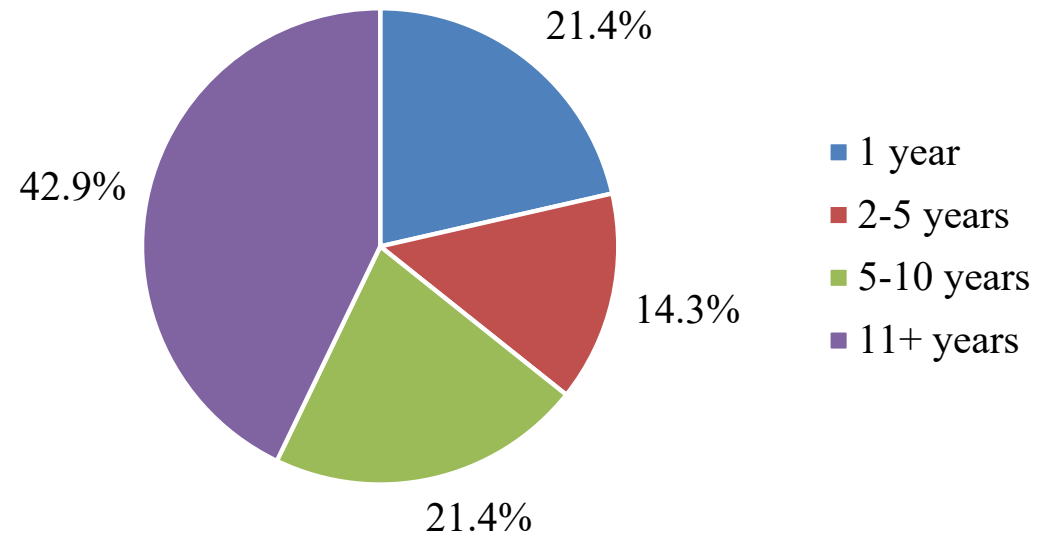

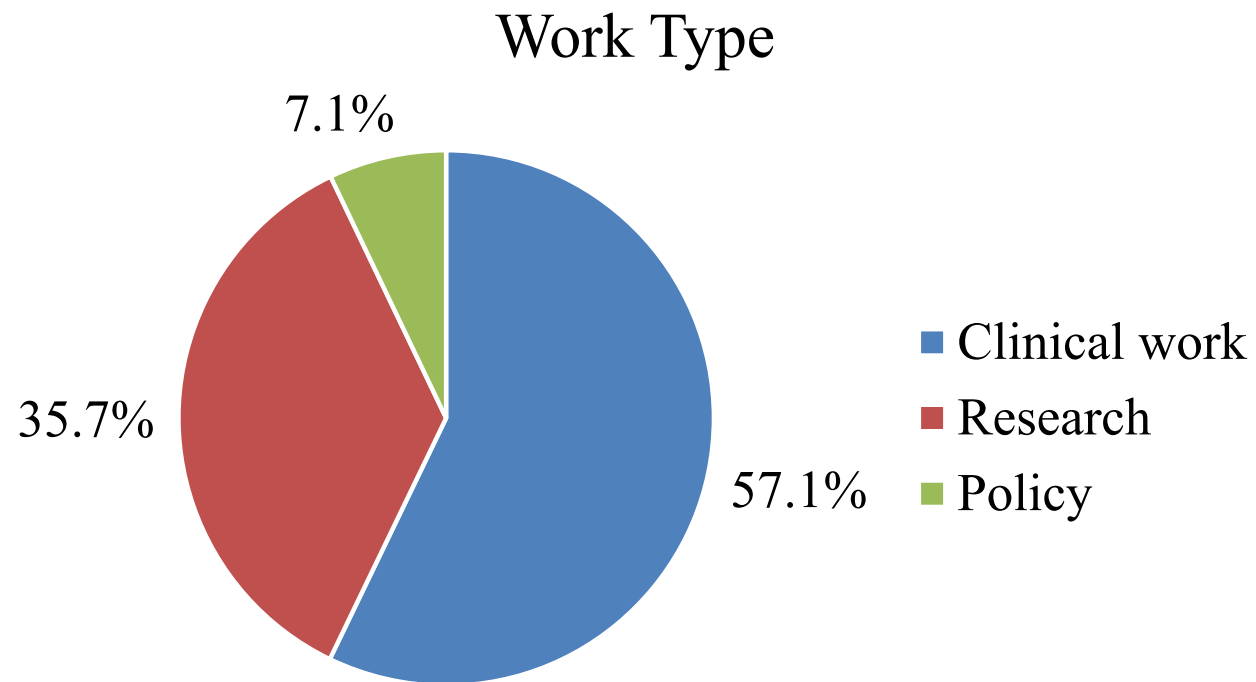

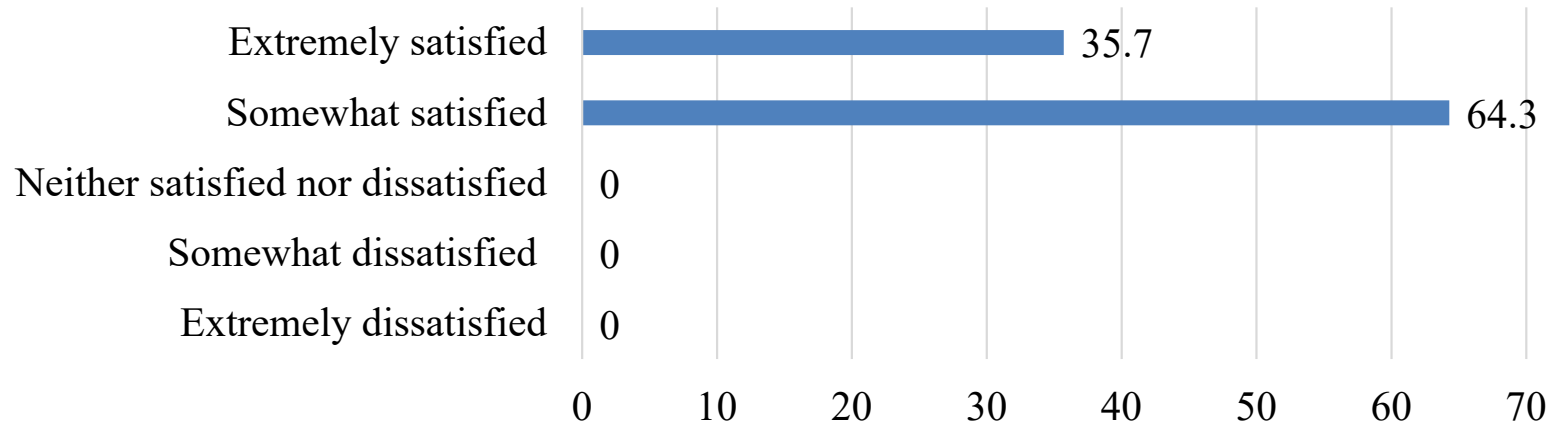
PAIG Membership Duration



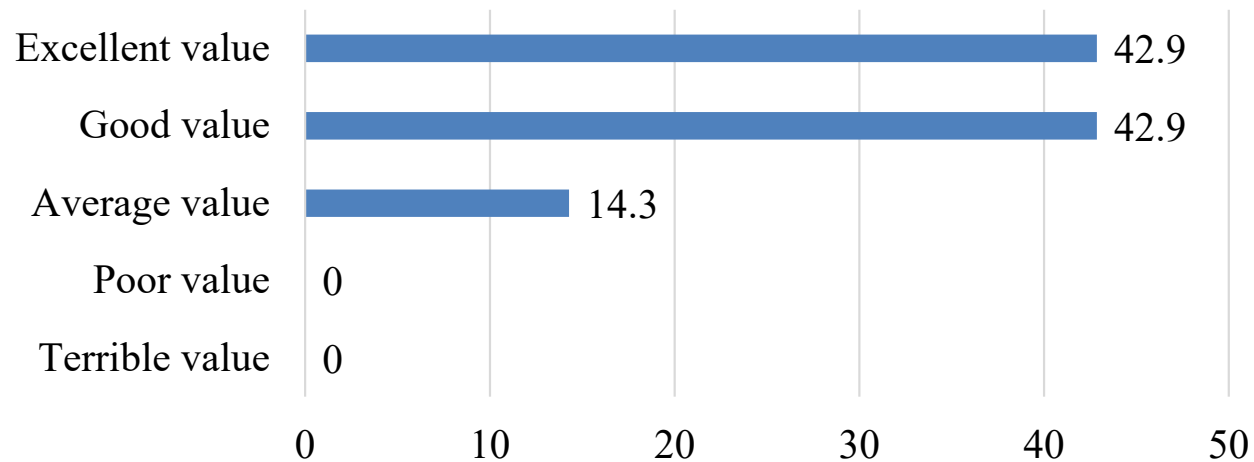


Satisfaction and value

Value for money

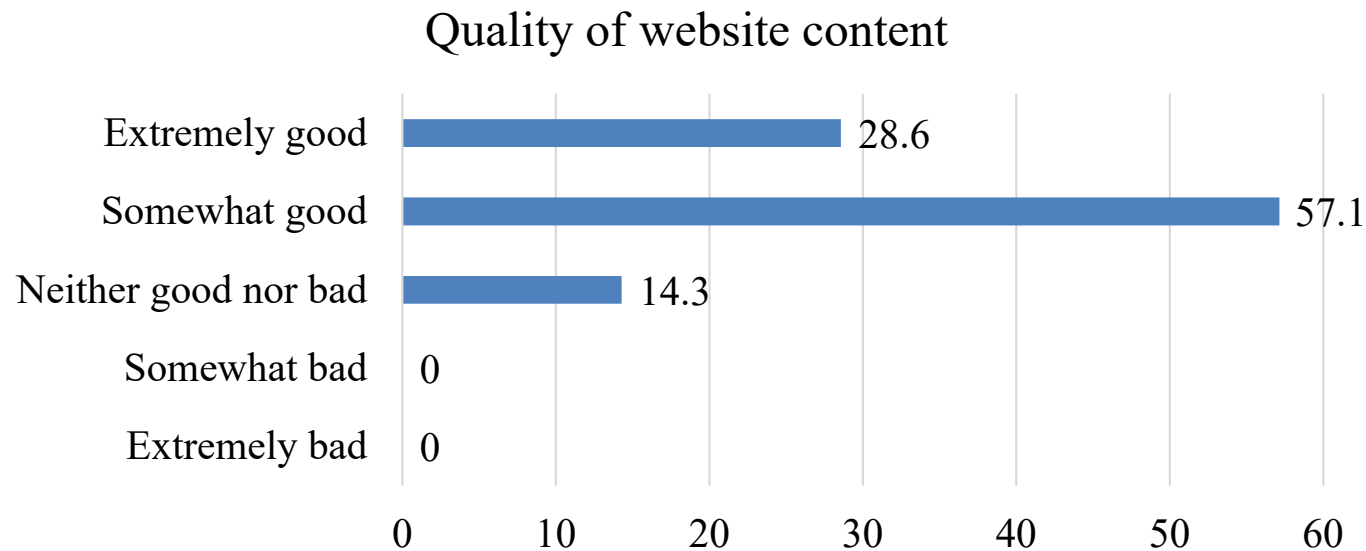


Workshops

- 36% had attended >1 workshop
- 100% rated the workshops as 'extremely good'
- 100% felt that based on their workshop experience, they would want to attend another workshop in 2022
- Suggested topics for 2022 workshops:
Working with existential issues and death anxiety, GAD in older adults, Grief and Loss in older adults

Website

- 50% had logged onto the website in the past year



- 93% were interested in PAIG compiling resources on evidence-based assessment and treatment for members (7% were unsure)

PAIG RACF Supervision Group



- 38.5% were interested in attending
- 15.4% were not interested
- 23.1% were not in a clinical role or don't work in RACF
- 23.1% were unsure

- 60% wanted online format, 40% either online or F2F, 0% want F2F.
